What is Commitment Weekend?

Commitment Weekend is one of the most important campaign events! During Commitment Weekend every family still praying about their decision will have the opportunity to consider their support at Mass. It is challenging for our volunteers to reach every parishioner, so this is a great way to drastically increase participation and receive decisions regarding the campaign. We also hope this will bring us close to our \$5,500,000 goal but we need your support!

Why Hasn't A Volunteer Contacted Me?

Due to the large size of our parish, our volunteers have not been able to visit or talk to everyone. Over the next week we will continue to reach out to all of our families. When called, please welcome our volunteers working on behalf of the parish.

What Type of Pledge Should I Consider? What Are Others Giving?

According to the principles of Christian stewardship, we ask that everyone give in proportion to their ability. We ask every household to consider a sacrificial pledge payable over a 5-year period. This is the only way we will be able to achieve our goal.

WHY IS MAKING A PLEDGE IMPORTANT?

Pledging enables you to consider a wonderful gift of substance that will allow us to meet our goal. It allows for a substantial gift within your economical means. For instance: Peter and Jane are asked to consider a pledge of \$6,500. Peter and Jane do not have \$6,500 at hand. But after prayerfully considering their finances throughout a five-year period, Peter and Jane did find a way to work within their means a way to allot \$25/week (\$108/month) for the next five years for the Campaign. Pledging allows for a thorough review of one's finances. Through this review, you can assess what you are able to sacrifice, for five years, to continue **Building on Faith**.
